

## Year 10 - History

<b>Curriculum intent</b>	In Year 10, History students begin their GCSE course. Students start their learning journey with their thematic study; studying the development of medicine from 1250 to the present day. This unit focuses on the nature of change and continuity over time, building an understanding of the factors that affect progress. In the Spring term, students will begin the Depth Study, examining Germany after the First World War and the economic, social and political conditions that helped Hitler into power. Students will examine differing interpretations of Nazi Germany, and the works of several history scholars, learning to analyse and evaluate their work. Students will be beginning to write historically independently.
