Curriculum intent	<p>In their final year of History at Longdendale, students will continue their drive to achieve in the final GCSE exams. Through their study of the Cold War period study the students will gain a detailed understanding of events that have shaped our modern world. The chronology, causes and consequences of the events are investigated in detail. In the final depth study of Early Elizabethan England, they will investigate an important period in British history in depth.
